## Feed and feed additive assessment system in China

In order to safeguard the safety of animal feed and animal product, Chinese government firstly published Regulation on the Administration of Animal Feed and Feed Additives in 1999 and revised in 2001. The newly revised Regulation was published in November 3, 2011 and has been enforced since May 1 this year. One of the highlights of the new Regulation is that all feed materials and feed additives species in animal feed production must be within the Feed Material Catalogue or Feed Additive Catalogue, the two Catalogues are established and published by MOA. Any feed material or feed additive must be gone through safety and efficacy assessment before it enters the Catalogue.

This presentation will introduce regulatory requirements for new feed and new feed additive assessment, process of the assessment, technical and administration guidelines for the assessment, function of National Feed Assessment Committee, which carries out the technical assessment, and efficacy and safety trial institutions involving in the assessment. The presentation will also give general information on Feed Additive Catalogue and newly published Feed Material Catalogue.
